TECHNOLOGY GUIDELINES (Grade 6-12)

Information and Communication Technology (ICT) has come to play a vital role in many aspects of our lives, and education is no different. Students are increasingly making use of ICT for word processing, conducting research, making digital presentations, watching online videos, and organizing & managing their own studies. In recognition of this reality, we have been looking into various models that would ensure students have adequate access to technology in the classroom. Our findings suggest that a "bring your own device (BYOD)" is the most suitable model for WRCA.

Students in Grades 6-12 will require a laptop that meets the following minimum requirements as part of their regular school supplies:

- 1. Ability to connect to a Wi-Fi network
- 2. Lightweight (less than 4 lbs.)
- 3. Long battery life (6+ hours per charge)
- 4. Full keyboard
- 5. Readable screen (at least 10" diagonal screen dimension)
- 6. Gr6-10 students require a mouse for design class

Personal preference also plays a role in deciding which device to get. Often a student will prefer a particular style of device, or a particular manufacturer of devices. If possible, you should accommodate a personal preference if doing so means your child will feel a greater sense of ownership and pride in the device they are using at school (and hopefully treat it with greater care and respect as a result).

DO NOT BUY AN iPad for your child to use as their primary computing device at school.

These devices will not effectively run the programs used in their Design course (C++, Arduino, and Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, etc.), and are less effective for day-to-day classroom tasks like word processing and managing assignments on ManageBac. For students in Grades 11-12, iPads and other tablets can make a good <u>SUPPLEMENT</u> to a laptop, but even in those grades it should not be your child's only computing device.

Student age should be considered when purchasing a device.

- A student in Grade 6 should absolutely have a smaller, lighter and cheaper device with as few
 external accessories as possible (avoid a device that requires an external keyboard that cannot
 be permanently attached to it, or has a unique and expensive writing stylus).
- A student in Grade 11-12 may want to consider purchasing a device that can continue to be
 used well into their post-secondary education. A costlier investment for these students could
 end up saving money in the long term.

If you purchase a MacBook and if you turn on parental controls, then your child will be unable to connect to the school Wi-Fi.

Software Provided by the School



The school has obtained student licensing for some commonly used applications. Families do not need to purchase licenses for the following products when they buy a laptop for their child:

- Office 365 Students in Grades 6-12 are provided with licenses that allow them to download and install the latest version of Office on (up to) five personal devices. Currently, the Office suite includes Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Publisher, Access, and Outlook.
- Adobe Creative Cloud The school provides Grades 6-12 students with a license for the entire Adobe Creative Cloud suite of programs (Photoshop, Premiere Pro, etc.). Students can download and Install Creative Cloud on (up to) two personal devices
