Notes:

- The tuition grid has been tied to IB Programmes. The restructuring means increases are different across grades with some as high as 10.4% and others as low as 0.5%, but the average overall increase is 5.7%.
- Second child remains at 70% of the first child tuition, but the third child has been slightly increased to 50% of the first child tuition, and the maximum tuition per family has been increased to \$1,700.
- The total amount (school fees and tuition) includes all mandatory fees (retreats, field trips, music trips up to G8, G5 music rentals, IB exams and basic grad fees), and it would not include optional fees (music trips G9 and above, G6 and above music rentals, athletic fees, skiing, MSL trips and extra optional grad fees). School fees have also been grouped based on the IB Programme instead of the actual per grade amount paid in the past.
